NEW SERVICE CHARGES

Effective August 1, 2016

- (1) Unless otherwise determined by the District, the 1/2" charge will only apply to customers whose total fixture value, as set out in AWWA Manual M-22, is less than 50 and the total interior living/working space to be served is less than 1,000 square feet. Although a 1/2" meter is listed in Manual M22, it is neither common nor readily available. Therefore, a 5/8" meter will be installed.
- (2) If the Water District determines that a 1" or larger meter is needed, the System Development Charge (SDC) will be determined by the Water District based upon the estimated consumption. If the Water District determines that a meter size must be increased solely for the purpose of providing private fire suppression service, the SDC will be based upon the meter size needed to provide water service other than the provision of private fire suppression service.
- (3) The SDC will be adjusted for all meter sizes after three full years of active peak season service history based upon actual consumption during the peak season of the second and third full calendar years.
